WinteRace 2024 from March 7th to 9th: Registrations are already open.

Only 70 teams driving historic and modern cars, provided they are iconic landmarks of the global automotive production, will be admitted to the event.

Cortina d'Ampezzo. Registrations are now open for the eleventh edition of **WinteRace Cortina**, which will take place from March 7th to 9th, 2024. As always, the organizers Rossella Labate and Stefano Sangalli have worked all summer to prepare the event, which will once again confirm the high level of quality for which the race is recognized by Italian and foreign competitors and partners. The launch of the event is already underway through social media and targeted communication during the main events dedicated to vintage or iconic cars. **WinteRace Cortina** will also be present at Auto e Moto d'Epoca in Bologna next October and at Arezzo Classic Motors in mid-January 2024.

"The **WinteRace Cortina**," organizers Rossella Labate and Stefano Sangalli remind us, "is an event of the A.S.I. (Automotoclub Storico Italiano) and will be listed on the calendar under the name of the Circolo Veneto AutoMoto d'Epoca Giannino Marzotto. The format of the event remains unchanged: there will be two stages, starting and finishing on Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo, covering just over 400 kilometers, mainly along the Dolomite roads. Among the novelties we have planned and wish to anticipate," continue the organizers, "in the first stage, there will be a crossing of the Alpe di Siusi with a visit to Prösels Castle in Fiè allo Sciliar, a return to Moena, and in the second stage, the passage through the Staulanza and Cibiana passes, a route through Cadore, and a brief stop at Heinfels Castle in Sillian, Austria."

WinteRace Cortina will allow the participation of 40 historic cars built before 1999 and 30 vehicles registered in the Icon section produced from 2000 to the present day, selected from those that meet the requirements to be considered iconic landmarks of the global automotive production.
