WinteRace Cortina: on Friday the first stage kicks off

On Friday, March 14th, at 9:00 AM, the first stage of the 12th edition of the WinteRace Cortina will set off from Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo. This winter event, part of the ASI calendar, is reserved for historic and modern cars in the ICON category.

Cortina d'Ampezzo. On Friday, March 14th, at 9:00 AM, the first of two stages of the 12th edition of the WinteRace Cortina will start from Corso Italia in Cortina d'Ampezzo. This winter event, part of the ASI calendar, under the name of the Circolo Veneto AutoMoto d'Epoca Gianni Marzotto, is open to 50 historic cars and 20 modern vehicles (manufactured from 2000 to today) in the ICON category, carefully selected as true milestones of the global automotive industry.

The first day's route will take participants through some of the most scenic mountain passes in the Dolomites. After departing from Cortina, the cars will cross the picturesque Forcella Cibiana Pass (1,530 m above sea level), known for its houses adorned with murals and as the gateway to the Val Zoldana, an area of extraordinary scenic and cultural interest where the silence of the mountains meets human history.

The race will then continue along the Passo Duran (1,605 m a.s.l.), a wild and breathtaking location offering stunning views of the Civetta and Moiazza peaks. This stretch features challenging hairpin turns that wind through forests and alpine meadows. After passing through Agordo, the event will move toward Gosaldo, at the foot of the Pale di San Martino, and then cross Passo Cereda (1,369 m a.s.l.), entering the Trentino region. Here, the skill trials will take place in the charming Alpine village of Siror. Upon arriving in Primiero, the participants will visit the ancient Pieve church and the Palazzo delle Miniere, a medieval building that highlights the area's rich history of metal extraction, housing an extensive collection of historical artifacts.

The cars will then be showcased to the public in Primiero's historic center, before continuing to San Martino di Castrozza, a town renowned for its deep connection to motorsport. The journey will include a lunch stop at Malga Ces, a picturesque alpine lodge surrounded by pastures.

The return to Cortina will follow part of the legendary San Martino di Castrozza Rally route, crossing the Passo Rolle (1,984 m a.s.l.), Passo Valles (2,032 m a.s.l.), and passing through Falcade and Lake Alleghe, dominated by the majestic Civetta Mountain wall.

The final stretch will take the participants over Passo Giau (2,230 m a.s.l.), an iconic pass where the last skill trials will take place on the descent toward Cortina. As per tradition, the event will conclude with the presentation of the cars and crews on Corso Italia starting at 5:30 PM. The public showcase will be hosted by journalist Savina Confaloni.
